# A Better India A Better world

Mr. N.R.Narayana Murthy (Founder Chairman of Infosys Technologies Ltd.) has recently come out with a book titled," A Better India A Better World".

It will be interesting to see what the author, known as "Corporate Gandhi" among his admirers, feels and writes about Mahatma Gandhi and his values.

"My Experiments with Truth" by Mahatma Gandhi is one of the three books that influenced his thinking deeply. He writes "Mahatma Gandhi opened my eyes to the importance of good leadership in raising the aspirations of people, making them accept sacrifices, to achieve grand vision, and most importantly in converting the vision into reality. Gandhi realized that trust in leaders is extremely important if the followers have to rise to commit to sacrifices. He unleashed the most powerful instrument for gaining trustleadership by example. He ate, dressed, traveled and lived like the poor. Maintaining Gandhi's simple style did pose lots of logistics and security problems..... But walking the talk was extremely important to the Mahatma who understood the pulse of our people like no other Indian Leader. The biggest lesson for me from Gandhi's book and life is the importance of leading people by example."

He cites Gandhiji as one of the leaders who have the courage to dream big and stand up for their beliefs, who have the power of creating a grand vision, and who can articulate the vision to a large mass of followers., -a leader who has instilled hope and confidence in them about the future, make them feel enthusiastic and proud about being part of the journey and to convert the vision into reality through hard work and excellence in execution."

Like anybody else, Mr.Murthy enumerates all the maladies that ail the nation, but he sounds an optimistic note. Says he," Today, we have political freedom but not economic freedom- the freedom from hunger, disease and illiteracy. I believe that achieving economic freedom is the responsibility of this generation. It is our charter to transform this society, fulfilling the dream of Mahatma Gandhi of wiping the tears from the eye of every poor child. Can we do it? My answer is an unequivocal yes. Do you know why I am so confident? .... I have tremendous confidence in

the power of youth, in the energy, confidence, determination and enthusiasm every one of our young citizens possesses in abundance"... He further adds," To achieve these goals we must create a civilized society- a society where every body has equal opportunity to better his or her life; where every child has food, shelter, health care, and education; a society where duties come before rights; where each generation makes sacrifices to make life better for the next generations"

We spontaneously nod in approval, when Mr.Murthy writes:" Somehow in this country it is fashionable to see ideals as an end in themselves without focus on implementation. In fact articulation is accomplishment enough for most of our intellectuals! This tendency to keep discussing an idea without making any progress towards implementation is sometimes taken to ridiculous levels. If my count is correct, we have had thirty three seminars on building a power station for Bangalore city over the last twenty five years. Yet there is still no power plant in Bangalore and we continue to suffer from blackouts." Yes; we have seen organizations whose sole business is to conduct seminars, workshops and awareness camps, that at the end of the day they have nothing to show as their results except the number of papers read.

In the light of the views of Mr.Narayana Murthy we are reassured that we are going on the right track in building a better India. Apart from conducting seminars, lectures, classes, examinations in schools, colleges and prisons etc., on the values of Gandhiji, Bharathiyar and Swami Vivekananda, we have 1000 children from the most depressed sections of first generation learners getting free education and proving their worth by excellent results year after year, village women and youth empowered by training in skills, 150 orphan and destitute children getting a good standard of living, Child labor eradicated in 15 villages, 60 destitute old people leading a happy life in their sun-set days, 35 dry cows deflected from slaughter houses, etc.

Enthused, motivated, and inspired we rededicate ourselves to our goals significantly as we enter the  $22^{nd}$  year of our existence.
