Dear Friends,

When we go for shopping, we always have a feeling that anything priced high is of good quality. We also say that if we want good quality we better pay for it. In this scenario, if something is available totally free of cost, we will bet that it will be of the poorest quality.

Many people, who came to Sevalaya in the initial stages, communicated to us that if we give everything free, then people will think it is of bad quality and also will not see the value in it. We have proved all of them wrong. Sevalaya school is a completely free school, there is no fee to be paid, we provide uniforms, books, note books, all stationery items, the smaller kids are even picked-up and dropped free of cost! When we started operating in that area, we realized that unless we give everything free of cost, children from the poorest sections are not going to come to school. The parents feel that by sending their kids to school, they are losing out the 'cooli' the child can earn during the day. The reality of the situation forced us to make our school totally free. Then came the theory that if it is free, it can't be of good quality and the beneficiaries themselves will not take it seriously. But the current year's 12th standard public exam results show that, the children have taken education very seriously and also quality education has been given to them free of cost. Yes, this year, Sevalaya's Mahakavi Bharathiar Higher Secondary School is the only state board school I in Thriuvallur district to get 100% results! The children are first generation school goers in their families, many have single parents, some have lost both parents, some don't even know their parentage, and all are from poor and rural background. To produce 100% results with such children is not an easy task. That too this year we had many

stumbling blocks. The 12th standard syllabus was revised and lot of material was added. The physics paper was very tough. We could not find a proper Chemistry teacher. In spite of all this, all kids have come out with flying colours.

Many teachers forgot their own families and stayed in campus till late night and came back early morning next day. There were no weekends for teachers as they were always waiting to help the kids. People don't do such things just for salary. We normally ask the village children also to stay in the campus from 15th January every year. But this year, somehow we decided to make them stay from October itself. This decision was very helpful to the children as the month of November saw unprecedented rains in and around Chennai and many huts in the near by villages were washed away. If the children had been at home then, they would have lost all their books, notes etc., which would have been an added problem. It was an additional expense for Sevalaya to keep the village kids also in campus as there were more children to be fed everyday, every meal, but it was worth it.

There were many volunteers who came on weekends to teach the kids. All of you contributed your might to buy the uniforms, books, note books etc., like every year. Above all, the kids had the best wishes from all of you. All this put together, has brought in this transformation in Kasuva village. Better Quality education, free of cost, to the needy has become a reality. Let us all pat ourselves on our backs.
