Dear Friends,

Auto drivers in India or atleast in Chennai don't have a great reputation. They are always seen as meddling with the meters, demanding excess fare, using "madras tamil", etc. We always hear bad news about them, for that matter any news in press in most of the times is bad news only! Is there nothing good to report? Recently "Dinamalar", a leading Tamil newspaper, reported the following news about an auto driver in Gujarat.

Mr.Raju Parvath, is an auto driver in Gujarat's Sanand area. He earns Rs 6000 (120 USD) per month and has a family to support. As per the Government norms, he falls in the lowest income category and is eligible for all freebies the Government distributes now and then, as a part of their "social welfare" schemes.

TATA group wanted to produce Nano cars from West Bengal – world's first 2000 USD car. Due to the political developments in that state, TATAs decided to shift their factory to Gujarat and they selected the Sanand area in Gujarat. Through Gujarat Government departments, TATAs tried to buy land in that area for setting up the factory. They found that a piece of land belonged to Mr.Raju Parvath and fixed the land value at Rs 1.9 crores (380,000 USD). They made out a cheque in the name of Raju Parvath and sent it to him.

Mr.Raju Parvath was shocked when he got the cheque. He can't even count the zeros in the amount column! He has never seen so much money in his life nor will he earn this much even if he drives his auto all his life. But he knew that his grandfather had already sold that piece of land few years back. May be the buyer had not changed the title of the land. So this money belongs to someone else – whoever bought that land – and not a cent is his rightful claim.

Mr.Raju decided to return the money. He went to Ahmadabad, the judicial capital of Gujarat, and met the Government department officials and told them that he wanted to return the money. The officials have not handled such a transaction before. They have only seen people queuing up and pushing and pulling each other to receive few hundred rupees worth of items which they get free – they tell lies, suppress income, bribe officials all to get what comes free from Government – but Mr.Raju coming all the way to the capital to return a huge sum – how to handle this? Finally they took back the money and Raju returned home with a clean heart, back to Sanand, back to his auto, to work and earn his living.

Such stories should get the top headlines in the newspapers and prime time slot in TV news. People like Raju Parvath should be celebrated as national heros. India is not just scams, match fixing, etc., we have millions of people like Raju Parvath, who don't come on centre stage or who don't attract media attention.

Let us spread positive news.

When it burns our fingers, we blame it. Still, in itself it is neither good nor bad.

According as we use, it produces a feeling of good or bad in us; so as is this world. It is perfect. By perfection means that it is perfectly fitted to meet its ends. We may all be perfectly sure that it will go on beautifully well without us, and we need not bother our heads wishing to help it."
