

The vision of Sevalaya is to serve the **rural** poor and transform them for an equitable, happy and fulfilled society with an improved quality of life.


# Mission

# Education

## (Mahakavi Bharathiyar Unit)

#### Mahakavi Bharathiyar Higher Secondary

**School** is a Govt. recognised, unaided School for classes from Montessori to Higher Secondary. It provides quality education 100% free to the rural, underprivileged children. The school provides value-based education to make the children self-reliant and responsible citizens. Teachings of Mahakavi Bharathiyar, Mahatma Gandhi and Swami Vivekananda are imparted to the children.

- Free Education from Montessori to Std XII (1 section English Medium for Stds VI to XI)
- Free uniforms, stationery, note books, bags
- Free transport till III Std
- Free breakfast (Thanjavur)
- Total school strength 2100+
- Minimal drop outs 2%
- Centum or near centum results in Board exams (Stds X, XI and XII)
- Free evening tuition centres for 120+poor children in 4 districts

## Mahakavi Bharathiyar Community

**College**, unaided, provides skill training to school dropout youth from the villages and helps them get jobs.

# **Rural Development**

### (Mahatma Gandhi Unit)

### **Environmental Education**

Sevalaya imparts environment education to its children and implements the same in the campus. It segregates the degradable and non degradable wastes for disposal. All 12 locations of Sevalaya are thus green zones.

## **Tapping Solar Energy**

80% of Sevalaya's electricity requirement at Kasuva centre is derived from solar energy.

#### **Organic Farming**

Organic Farming is implemented in the two centres namely, Kasuva and Thirumalaivaiyavur. Cow dung, Panchakavya and Vermicompost are used as bio fertilizers. Sevalaya conducts regular workshops to propagate organic farming.

#### Vinobhaji Gaushala

Vinobhaji Gaushala shelters dry cows. It also shelters cows yielding milk which is consumed by residents.

## **Mobile Medical Camps**

Mobile Medical Camps are conducted every day in 4 villages- 2 in Thiruvallur and 2 in Kanchipuram district. Dedicated team of doctors and nurses conduct camps using mobile medical vans, for eye, dental and general check up and physiotherapy. Free medicines are given for the benefit of the residents, school, staff and villagers.

## Swami Vivekananda Boys Home and

Mother Teresa Girls Home (Partly aided, recognized as "Children's Home" under Dept. of Social Defence, Govt. of Tamilnadu)

Presently these homes shelter around 200 children. These homes provide food, education, opportunities for skill development and talent promotion in an atmosphere of love and care.

These children are taken care of till they become self reliant. Many of the children are now well settled in life, pursuing careers as qualified mechanics, electricians, artisans, bank officers, nurses and software professionals.

## Sri Ramakrishna Paramahamsa Old

Age Home (Unaided, recognized by the Social Welfare Department, Govt. of Tamilnadu) in Kasuva centre and Gandhi Ashram Krishnan Memorial Senior citizens' Home in Thanjavur

Sevalaya provides a life with dignity for 80 destitute elders in the evening of their lives in these Homes.

**Integrated Campus** (Aided, Recognized by the Social Welfare Department, Govt. of Tamilnadu)

Sevalaya has been selected by the Govt. of Tamilnadu for implementation of its programme in Thiruvallur District, the Integrated Campus under which 25 destitute senior citizens and 25 destitute children are housed in one campus.

- Old Age Home housing 80 senior citizens in Kasuva and Thanjavur
- Integrated Campus housing 25 senior citizens and 25 children in the same campus

# CROSSING STATE BOUNDARY TO ANSWER KERALA'S CALL FOR HELP

The rescue and relief operation that followed the call for help from flood-hit Kerala meant breaking the traditional operational boundary of Tamil Nadu state.

The skies opened up in the first week of August 2018, most dams were opened and gushing water submerged most of Kerala. Officially, 206 people lost their lives, and lacs of people were rendered homeless.

With the prior experience in organising relief work during the Chennai floods in 2015, Sevalaya reacted swiftly and the first truck load of relief materials were despatched to Kerala on 18<sup>th</sup> August 2018. The consignment consisted of clothing, water bottles, blankets, buckets and mugs. Many Sevalaya staff including those working on kitchen, gaushala and agricultural field, with meagre income, willingly came forward to donate one day's salary for the relief operations.

After the initial relief work, Sevalaya took up the rehabilitation work. Partnering with Fiat Chrysler Automobile (FCA), under "Project Shelter", Sevalaya constructed houses for 15 families who lost their homes in the floods and landslides in Vazhathope Panchayat in Idukki District, Kerala. The beneficiaries were identified with the help of the local Panchayat.

Measuring 487 Sq. ft, each house has 2 bedrooms, a hall, a washroom and a

kitchen, with a small courtyard in the front. They are ready to live, fitted with fans, lights, taps and washbasin.

The entire Project was completed in 4 months and the houses were handed over to beneficiaries by H Dineshan, IAS, District Collector, Idukki.

I work for daily wages and my husband does all odd jobs. My only son is in high school. Thanks to Sevalaya

# RS 15 LACS WORTH OF RELIEF, 4 HOMES, FOR GAJA CYCLONE VICTIMS

Gaja cyclone that hit Thanjavur district in December 2018, left the areas completely devastated. Sevalaya was among the first to reach with relief services, within 24 hours. 6,000 food packets were served daily for a week, from the kitchen of Sevalaya's old age home at Thanjavur. In a week's time, relief kits containing essential items were reached to the victims.

Four pukka houses worth 5 lacs were constructed and handed over to four beneficiaries in Andinatham Village, Orathanadu Taluk, Thanjavur, who had lost their huts in the cyclone. The four beneficiaries are the sole breadwinners of their families.



The college offers free training in Tailoring, basic computer applications and AC & Refrigeration Mechanic courses. Thirubuvanai, being an industrial area, has demand for skilled students. For unemployed youth from Thirubuvanai and the neighbouring villages of Thiruvandarkovil and Madagadipattinam, an escape from a deadend is in the offing. # **MANAGING TRUSTEE'S REPORT**

## Dear Friends,

Sevalaya has been on a path of continuous growth in the 3 decades. The growth and expansion is not just geographical but also the range of services for the underprivileged.

Sevalaya has been continuously reaching out to the destitute and the needy, offering its services for their wellbeing. But the year 2018- 19, saw many donors, corporates seeking Sevalaya, entrusting the responsibility of implementing projects which they were willing to fund. The past year presented us with more opportunities to serve. And as always, there was expansion of the ongoing projects.


Sevalaya's core activities of care for underprivileged children and senior citizens, school education, skill development, feeding the hungry, animal welfare, organic farming, health, environment related activities, rural development activities, sports, spreading the message of Bharathi, Gandhi and Vivekanananda etc. were also carried out in full swing.

One new challenge in recent years has come from natural calamities at increasing frequency. Corporate and individual donors came forward to partner with Sevalaya for effective implementation of rehabilitation projects for victims of natural disasters.

The strength of the Homes touched 200, children in school crossed 2100, skill development beneficiaries around 1000 and many thousands were benefitted by our feeding the hungry program and awareness programs. The staff strength has crossed 250.

## Expansion

A new Community College was opened in Sunguvarchathram in Kanchipuram District offering free 4 months training in tailoring and basic computer applications. The courses are sponsored by PPG Asian Paints.

R S Nallaperumal, a longstanding donor and well-wisher of Sevalaya donated his ancestral house at Ravanasamudram for running a community college there. Free 4 months course tailoring and basic computer applications are offered for the poor youth in the village and its surroundings. The centre also provides training in craft. Basic computer applications course is sponsored by Lionbridge Technologies. The tailoring machines for the tailoring course is sponsored by M/s. Hyundai Transys Lear Automotive India Pvt Ltd.

Sevalaya stepped out of Tamilnadu for the first time by opening up a community college in Thirubuvanai, Puducherry. Four months free training in tailoring, Basic computer applications and AC & Refrigeration Mechanic are offered in this college. This initiative is sponsored by PPG Asian Paints.

named Sevalaya's Gandhi Ashram Krishnan Memorial Senior citizens Home. The land was donated by K Muthuramakrishnan, Advisor, Sevalaya, and the construction of one wing of the Home was sponsored by Petrofac and Sevalaya USA.

As in the past years special focus on honing sports talents among the children continued. A state of the art, well equipped Gymnasium cum fitness centre is an additional facility sponsored by Petrofac. This has improved the fitness level of the children participating in sports.

The academic year saw 3 students S Gomathi, E Gomathi and D Gayathri getting seats with hostel facility in




Queen Mary's College under sports quota with full scholarship. 2 boys Aravindasamy and Santosh also got admission in sports quota in Nehru College of Arts and Sciences, Coimbatore. Nearly 40 day scholars and 25 hostel students practice for 2 hours daily and special nutritional supplements are given to them. Lionbridge Technologies sponsors the sports special coaching and healthy nutritional diet supplements.


A new ophthalmology clinic is now functional in Sevalaya Medical Centre at Kasuva Centre twice a week, in association with Bohra Eye hospital. Free eye screening is done and medicines provided for the residents as well as the villagers. Free cataract surgeries are performed for those who require, at the Bohra Eye Hospital, Avadi.


### Infrastructure development

Many improvements in infrastructure were made at Kasuva Centre thanks to the generous contribution of Page Pierre Foundation, Switzerland. The Boys Home and Girls Home buildings were renovated and got a new look. The Foundation also sponsored the purchase of new Montessori kits for the preprimary section. A spacious well ventilated reading room above the library building was also sponsored by Page Pierre Foundation. The library is well equipped with many new books and Audio visual systems. A 30 seater bus for transporting sports students to local tournaments, practice sessions, competitions and sports camps was also sponsored by the Foundation.

Separate toilet blocks for girl students were constructed with the support of M/s. Hyundai Transys Lear Automotive India Pvt Ltd and Amrutanjan Ltd., A separate incinerator room is also constructed.









# **Academic Performance**

Dropout rate in 2018-2019 : 2%

Total school pass percentage for all classes : 99.02%

(This mean that out of every 100 students who joined our school at Kindergarten, 98% students came out successful, passing the Higher Secondary (XII grade) Examination this year.)



RR Donnelly donated a new 30 seater bus for taking elders on tours to temples and educational tours for students.

## Improvements to ongoing activities

The ongoing activities saw remarkable improvements.

The students secured 100% pass in XII and 97.08% in X Std and 98.41% in XI Std Board examinations held in March 2019. Many individuals, associations and corporates like Dr. Krishnamurthy, USA, Help Foundation, USA, Standard Chartered Bank Global Business Services, CAMS, BNY Mellon, Asian Paints, Gurukrupa Foundation, Sevalaya USA and Woori Bank supported the cause of education.

BNY Mellon, Latentview and Help Foundation, USA also sponsored the higher education of students who completed XII Std in Sevalaya and went on to pursue college education.

We observed that lack of knowledge in spoken English is a major hurdle for the students who pass out of our school and pursue higher education. Hence Spoken English classes are conducted for students from Primary school to Community colleges. The spoken English classes are sponsored by Lionbridge Technologies, Shikshadaan and BNY Mellon.

Usha Rangarajan, Trustee, coordinated career guidance sessions for students of Std X, XI and XII, by inviting people from various industries.

Standard Chartered Global Business Services (SCGBS) sponsored Goal programme by NAZ Foundation India. The programme aims at imparting life skills through games for girls. The children were provided coaching in Netball. Sevalaya team were selected for the "One Nation Netball Cup" National Tournament conducted in new Delhi and reached upto Pre Quarter finals.

Many training Programmes – both in-house and external - were organised for the staff. R S Nallaperumal, Educationist conducted a 3 day workshop for teachers on teaching methodology, understanding the students and how to make class interesting. 2 teachers went to Educational Leadership training by Kuruvilla Jacob Initiative for promoting excellence in school education. Teachers training programmes are sponsored by Maara Breech Foundation, USA.

P Prasanna, Vice President, Corporate Relations, A A Kingston, Vice President, Operations and L N Anupriya, Head, Donor Relations - Retail, attended a three day Leadership Development Programme for NGOs organised by Xavier Institute of Management and Christian Institute of Management.

The BGV Moral education sessions by Sevalaya reached out to 12,000 students in 72 schools in 12 districts of Tamilnadu this year. Sevalaya also organised the staging of Bharathi Yaar? a bioplay on Mahakavi Bharathi by SB Creations for the school toppers in Thanjavur District.

# Volunteers

This year also we had 3 volunteers from Project trust UK, who stayed in our Kasuva Campus for 1 year, helping out the children in hostel, teaching them in school, interacting eith elders and helping us in social media campaigns.

810 volunteers from different corporates including Standard Chartered GBS, BNY Mellon, LTI, DTCC, PwC, Thermax, WolterKluwer and Tata Communications engaged themselves in activities like classroom painting, hostel painting, campus cleaning, conducting training sessions for children like greeting card making, tree plantation, seed balls making and working in our organic farms.

We also organised a mega Beach cleaning programme at Elliots beach, Besant Nagar, Chennai with 500 volunteers from LTI.

We also had more than 350 NSS volunteers from various colleges like DRBCC Hindu Collge, Chellammal College for Women, Dr Ambedkar Law University, Dr MGR Janaki College of Arts and Sciences for women and Patrician College. Sevalaya thanks all the volunteers who spent time with the beneficiaries of Sevalaya and got involved in school, hostel, organic farming, Gaushala, medical centre, sports, community college and village development activities.

Seed Ganesha was a new initiative this year. Eco friendly idols of Ganesha embedded with seeds and organic manure were made by our community college students and staff and distributed to over 500 interested donors during Ganesh Chathurthi. days the seeds sprouted and plants grew out of Ganeshas.

## Donors

Sevalaya does not receive any Government grant, except for the Integrated Campus project and a portion of children home expense. (Integrated campus project is an initiative of Social welfare department, Government of Tamil Nadu, under which 25 senior citizens and 25 destitute children are housed in one campus. Government provides a part of the running expense for this activity. Sevalaya was selected by the Government to run this project in Thiruvallur district). Sevalaya continues to run 95% on donations made by well-wishers. These donations which form the life blood of the organisation could range from a small one-time amount from an individual to large amounts given regularly by foundations and corporates. The donor could be anyone from a local person who lives a

#### Moving Forward...

Initially Sevalaya wanted to build a high quality free school for 1000 underprivileged children. But we saw the results and motivated to do

more, so we created more space and expanded the school to cater for 2000 children. Now the school functions at an optimum capacity, not being able to meet the huge demand. The management has started thinking about another school, may be to house 2000 more kids, providing access to quality education to more number of underprivileged children.

Sevalaya would like to increase its presence all over Tamil Nadu. We plan to do more community development projects. Sevalaya's "Model Village" project includes a free health centre, community toilet block, installation of RO plant to provide clean drinking water and free tuition centre in the evenings for the poor children in the village. We are looking out for opportunities to implement the "Model Village" Project in villages that lacks these basic amenities.



810 volunteers from corporates including Standard Chartered GBS, BNY Mellon, LTI, DTCC, PWC, Thermax, Wolter Kluwer and Tata Communications engaged themselves in various activities. They did classroom painting, campus cleaning, conducting training sessions for children such as greeting card making, tree plantation, seed balls making and working in our organic farms.

Also in our plan is to open a Medical Centre specialising in Health care for adolescent women in Thillaiyadi Village in Nagappattinam District, in memory of Thillaiyadi Valliammai. Valliammai was a young freedom fighter, who, under the

away on her sixteenth birthday on 22<sup>nd</sup> February 1914.

Feeding the hungry was the main idea adopted by Sevalaya from the teachings of Swami Vivekananda. Every day 1400 free meals are served at Sevalaya's canteen at Kasuva Centre which includes the 300 residents of the Children and Senior citizens homes and 2000+ children in Thanjavur.



# **Extending healthcare to 30,000 beneficiaries**

Sevalaya's Mahatma Gandhi Medical Centre in Kasuva campus provides free health services to the residents of Sevalaya and to 40 villages in and around Kasuva. This 12 bedded facility is open for 12 hours a day with two doctors and nurses. Free medicines are also provided. A clinical lab, with facilities for complete blood tests, blood sugar levels, renal function test, routine urine examination, urine pregnancy test and Widal (to detect typhoid), is also attached to the medical centre. On an average, the health centre serves 29,000 villagers.

The Physiotherapy Centre at Kasuva functions for 8 hours a day. 1000 villagers are benefitted annually.

An ophthalmology clinic, in association with Bohra Eye Hospital, also functions

in Kasuva Centre. Twice a week, free eye check-up is done and medicines are provided to the residents as well as the villagers. Those who require cataract surgery are referred to Bohra eye hospital. Beneficiaries of the clinic exceed 1,000, including 47 patients who underwent free cataract surgeries.

Employing two Mobile Medical Vans, Sevalaya serves around 80 villages in Thiruvallur and Kanchipuram Districts, through monthly visits and free medical camps. Four villages each are covered every day. Free medicines are also distributed to the patients. Annually, 25000 villagers are benefitted by these camps. Another 450 villagers are benefitted by free physiotherapy camps. The Medical centre at Kasuva also

conducts Health and Hygiene Awareness

camps in the villages.

Sevalaya runs a medical centre in Nathamedu village, Thiruvallur District securing nearly 100 villagers every day. SPONSORS:

# Seeding a green idea through Seed Ganesha

Can Ganesh Chathurthi be eco-friendly? Can the festival double up as a greening initiative? Sevalaya answered in the affirmative both these questions, with the support of its committed donor community. Sevalaya helped 500 willing donors to celebrate the festival in an eco-friendly way. Around 500 idols of Ganesha were made by the students of Sevalaya's community college and the staff. Two dozen from the Sevalaya family put up their hands to go on delivery trips, on jeeps, trucks and own two wheelers. Among them were teachers, hostel wardens, Managers and office staff.

The idols were door delivered to 500 donors. The response was so overwhelming that the idols could not be delivered to some donors. When meeting the donors, the volunteers explained what to do: after the pooja, the idols have to be placed in a pot and watered regularly, when the seeds inside will sprout and grow into plants.


