Sevalaya has traversed one more year in its well-charted path and we are happy to present a report of our activities of 1996-97 in different areas.

HOSTEL

As at the close of the year we had with us 57 children of whom 14 were girls. Work of construction of a separate block for girls, named after Mother Theresa was inaugurated by Ms. S P. Sarguna Pandiyan, 'Hon'ble ministre for Social welfare on 28th September 1996. We are happy to report that the block has now been completed and the girls have moved to the new accommodation.

EDUCATION

School-Recognition: Recognition of Mahakavi Bharathiyar School at Elementary School level has been received after a long delay of four years. Although all requirements were complied with by us then and there, the delay was due to pure bureaucratic red-tape. Our thanks are due to Mr. P.T.R. Palanivelrajan whose timely intervention and no-nonsense approach got us the recognition within 24 hours of our approaching him Mr. Y.V. Subbe Rao of Combatore, Mr. Parthasarathy of Tiruvallur and Mr. Jayaraman of Edapalayam were following up the matter. Ms. Revathy Menon, Ms.Sulochana Ramachaseshan and Prof.Ramachandran of Tiru. nelveli effectively intervened in the matter. Ms. Rasheeda Baghat's article in the Indian Express high-lighted our plight and triggered action at the Governmental level. We remembered and thanked all of them in a function at Sevalaya on 8-11-96

Application has been submitted for recognition of the school at High School level and we are hopeful of an early favourable decision.

Balwadi

Onr Balwadi class has from March 97 been adopted by tndian Red Cross Society, Tiruvallur District unit. We have to Ihank Ms. Jayashree Raghunanthan, Collector of Tiruvallur District and Dr. Bhooma Srinivasan, Secretary IRCS, for their initiative in this regard.

Special Education

Weekly Lectures on special topics and daily sessions on lives of great men for imparting values, and Karate and Yoga classes etc., continued this year.

Annual Educational Camp

Three day aided-camp was conducted at Camp Tonakela, Ayapakkam, Avadi on 2nd, 3rd and 4th May 1996. A day each was dedicated to Mahatma Gandhi. Swami V.vekananda and Mahakavi Bharathiyar. Mr. P. Annamalai of Gandhi Study Centre, Mr. T. Ramalingam, Tamil Scholar and Mr. K. Thangaraj/Mr. T. S. Venkataramani talked to the children on these great leaders and Quiz Programmes were conducted at the end of these sessions. Sports events, Competitions and plays were part of this camp. Prizes for the events were sponsored by Mr. T. Arunachalam, Managing Director, Sanmac Group. Lion. Sampath Murugan presided over the valedictory function and distributed the prizes.

'Antharyogem' one day session was conducted for our children on 18th August 1996. The preceptor was Mr. Muthuramakrishnan of Thanjavur.


Higher Education

MEDICAL CENTRE

Mahatma Gandhiji Medical Centre continues to serve our children and the rural people alike under the attention of a full time nurse. Besides this medical camps are periodically conducted. On 21-7-96 a medical camp was conducted by Abhimaan, a voluntary service organisation of chennai.

On 7th December Polio pulse campaign and 15-12-96 Blood donation camp was conducted with the support of the same organisation. On 28-1-97, a medical, medical education and Blood donation camp was conducted jointly by Abhimaan, Lioness. Club of Nandambakkam and A.M. Jain college N.S.S.

SWAMI VIVEKANANDA LIBRARY

Our Library has been strengthened by further addition of books. A Library hour is allocated for our children and they are provided with a fixed number of pre-selected books to study and discuss. Villagers are also encouraged to use our library and reading room.

DEVELOPMENT AND TRAINING

All our staff are given induction training of one-day on selection. Besides this for our teaching staff a one day seminar on teaching methodology was conducted by Ms. MohanaChandrasekaran, Principal, National Public School, Chennai, and Ms. Vijayalakshmi of Chennai. On 24-8-96 a one day motivation workshop for all our staff members was conducted by Mr. Sentilathiban, H.R.D. Specialist, of Chennai, Dr. Susila Mariappan career guidance counsellor, Chennai University and Mr. S. Rajalingam Joint Director (Employment-Career study) interacted with our children on 23-11-96 and 30-11-96 respectively.

Our higher-standard students took the psychometric test conducted by Anandavikotan-NIS Sparta and the results received are taken note of to determine their higher level studies and career-pursuit.

PREMISES

As reported earlier, Mother Theresa girls hostel block been constructed, and a block has also been constructed members, sponsored by Tamil Nadu Nadu Swabimaan.

Bhoomi Puja was conducted on 9.2-97 for the school building block. Class rooms-sponsored by Rathna & Rao Wisdom Trust is nearing completion.

During the year steps have been taken to have a garden, children park and a playground in the premises.

COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES

Pamphlets were widely circulated in the adjoining villages to popularise the use of our school, library, reading room and medical centre.

Sports was conducted for the village children and prizes were distributed. A Film show on Gandhiji based on clipping of films from News reels was shown in the villages on 5-10-96. On October 6th immediately preceding the Panchaya Elections, a video show on Panchayat Raj was also exhibited:

A.M. Jain College National Service Scheme members conducted a 10 day camp at Sevalaya from 24-01-97 and a similar camp of Ethiraj College members was for 5 days from 24-02-97. The camps rendered service at the villages. A.M. Jain College volunteers conducted a house-to house survey on literacy etc.,

On 21-7-96, 'Abhimaan' conducted an introductory session for village youth on self-employment and enterpreneurship opportunities. Following up this, there was a one day seminar on 21-09-96 in which Dr R. Natarajan, Joint Director, Government of Tamil Nadu, Mr Asokan, SISI, Mr. L Pandiarajan, and Lion Mahadavan of LIC participated.

On 1st December 1996 at the initiative of Sevalaya a meeting of newly elected Panchayat representatives and the public of the villages was addressed by Dr. M. S. Udaya. murthy. He spoke on the rights and responsibilities of the elected representatives. It was decided to have similar meetings once in 2 months and to have 'Gram Sabha' once in 8 months at Sevalaya. Mr. Doraikannu, President Panchayat Union, Puliyur-Pakkam and Mr. Dayalan, Councillor are to be congratulated on their responsiveness to the initiative of Sevalaya.

On 15-3-97, at the initiative of Sevalaya 'Sakthi Exnora' was inaugurated at Sivanvoil village. Ms. Ravathy Menon, Mr. M. B. Nirmal, Ms. Sulochana Ramaseshan besides local representatives and Inspector of Vengal Police Station, Mr. John Jesudaiyar participated. As a result of this, the illicit arrak problem in this village has been eradicated.

On the same day a' face-to-face' meeting with the elected representatives and the local public was conducted at Sevalaya in the presence of Mr. M. B. Nirmal, Ms. Revathy Menon and Ms Sulochana Ramaseshan. These dignitaries also addressed.

In June 96, we deputed two persons from the nearby villages and one student of Sevalaya for a 10 day Training course on electrical work conducted by abhimaan. They have successfully completed the course.

Sevalaya also effectively intervened in a case of Environmental Pollution by two local brick chambers who used industrial waste oil in the place of coal, and with the help of Civic Exnora, and Collector, Chengalpattu District to see to it that this practice was stopped.

Brief History of Sevalaya

sevalaya, is a voluntary organisation registered under Sevalayer Sevalayer Trusts Act in India. It is running an orphanage at a running an orphanage at sevalayer plitable vavillage, near Chennai (Madras), South India.

Sevalaya, managed by a board of 2 trustees, started funcon the 29th May 1988, with 5 children in a small rented in Sivanvoil village near Kasuva Now Sevalaya shelters children and provides them with food, clothing, shelter, children and medical aid absolutely free of cost. purerus 10-6 d cm may.

Sevalaya provides shelter to, any orphan child without discrimination on the basis of caste / colour / creed / igion / language / sex etc. The application form which the ardian of a child has to complete while admitting a child, ks no information about the child's caste or religion. In fact, the entrance to the premises itself Sevalaya implores its sitors to shed all their preferences / prejudices on the basis of ste / creed / religion / language / sex etc. before entering. he institution does its best of instill in the minds of the hildren that all human beings are equal while teaching them bout the principles of various religions. should group que no to racin remarks

Sevalaya constantly strives to find out the interests / alents of each child in the institution and provides them with pportunities to develop in their respective fields of interest. hildren excel in the field of sports also. Many children have von prizes in many athletic events.

To bring out the talent in the children in the field of writng essays, poems, stories, jokes, drawing pictures, etc., the astitution encourages them to prepare a monthly manuscript magazine in Tamil named 'VIDIYAL' (Dawn). The magazine is pepared entirely by the children have also participated and won pizes in inter-school competitions.

Kasuva, the village in which Sevalaya is situated, does have a school with minimum guidance the children nor is there

any school within the radius of 2 Kilo meters. Hence most any school within the radius of 2 control at all or they are the children in the village do not go to school at all or they are the children in attending school which is far away. very irregular in attending school which is far away.

Hence to provide a good and sound primary education not only to the inmates of Sevalaya but also to the local village not only to the inmates of Several Bharathiyar School' is run by children, a school, 'Mahakavi Bharathiyar School' is run by children, a school, 'Mallaka', by Sevalaya, providing free education to all the children for classes Sevalaya, providing free education that all the children in the 1 to 10. Sevalaya's teachers and take personal care of each village attend school regularly and take personal care of each and every child.

Kasuva is a remote village where there are no cocors or government health centres and the nearest doctor is 6 Kilo meters away. To reach medical aid even in case of emergency, the villagers have to travel 6 Kilo meters, of which the first 2 kilo meters have to be covered by foot as there is no public transport facility. To counter this, Sevalaya is now running a free medical centre, 'Mahatma Gandhiji Medical Centre', With a nurse working there full time and a doctor visiting the clinic twice a month. The medical centre serves the villagers in and around Kasuva. The nurse visits every household to attend to pregnant women and gives pre-natal and post-natal advice.

Sevalaya also runs a free library 'Swami Vivekananda Library', for the children of Sevalaya, as well as for the public. This is to encourage the habit of reading among the village people and thereby making them aware of the happenings in the world they live in.

Sevalaya is also planning to start an old age home for the destitute aged people.

Sevalaya which started functioning from a small rented place, has now purchased 1.5 acres of land for the construction of school and hostel buildings, with the help of generous donations received from members of the public, various public Welfare Organisations, staff of various organisations, and industrialists.

Sevalaya, apart from providing shelter and better opportunities for the destitute children, has also done its part in providing the basic necessities of a village namely school, medical centre and a library.

GOAL OF SEVALAYA

Well being of a society depends on the Inperated Development of its children. Integrated pevelopment in essence involves Character Building Education. Parents are are responsible for the prowth of the Children, and for Orphan Children, society has to take up this responsibility. Sevalaya dedicated to play this role to the best of its capacity. It is also our goal that the Children so brought up should become Good Citizens and help the society to their best ability.







The object of 'Samarpana' is to establish and administer pecial homes, training and day-care centres for the spastics, specially retarded, disabled children etc.

Samarpana has established and is running the following two residential centres.

- 1) The NEST A home for spastics
- II) The RAINBOW A home for mentally retarded

These two residential centres are now providing shelter for about 25 inmates. The inmates are aged from 6 to 48 years and a few of them are from houses with single parents. Others are orphans and destitutes.

Samarpana provides specialised services like physiotherapy, speech, therapy, special education and vocational training for these children. These are provided by Mr. B.M. Sridhar and Ms. K. Bhavani who had undergone special training in these fields.

The spastic children are given special training in their day-to-day activities of toileting, brushing, bathing, dressing, drinking and eating These neglected children of god are also taught language skills (receptive expressive) and academic skills (like reading, writing number, time and money) by the specialised and trained staff of the Organisation.





These camps, therefore, if properly organised with meaningful programmes and trained boys and girls work leaders, will no doubt provide an effective method for the character education of our boys and girls, therefore the method for the character education of our boys and girls.

Wallace Forgie, a dedicated boys' work leader, who had a vast experience of such camps, when he came to work in the Madras YMCA from Canada, found a deplorable lack of facilities for this invaluable activity here. He set out, therefore, to extablish the unique and pioneering organisation. Camp Tonakela, and devoted forty years of his life in this service to promote the welfare of our boys and girls.

The camp was officially opened in the year 1938 and was named 'Camp Tonakela' in honour of Ethel Statten, a Canadian lady who was a social worker in Canada organising camping in Canada for girls. The present site was purchased by Forgie in the year 1946 and he developed the camp site living there in a small building built in the camp site. After Wallace Forgie passed away in the year 1967, the Camp Tonakela Association started by him carried on the activities initiated by him.

The main objects of the camp are :

1. to provide a well equipped camp site for the use of any and all groups of boys and girls who had suitable and adequate leadership.

- 2. to conduct training in camping and in the leadership of every form of character building activities and
- 3. to establish and conduct such other activities as may prove necessary and desirable in the furtherence of these and related aims.

Apart from providing cheaply and readily a well equipped camp site for the use of groups of boys and girls, Forgie arranged for groups of children from the weaker sections of the community to be given the camping experience for two or three days providing food and other amenities free of cost. These are the Aided Camps.

During the year 1995-96, we had 60 camps with 5,297 participants and 7 aided camps with 210 underprivileged children. Two hundred and thirty groups with 5,737 participants had picnics in the camp site. The swimming pool with the water treatment plant attracted 14,993 persons during that year. There are also other activities such as tailoring classes for women in the Vocational Training Centre and the children's 'club with members from the adjacent villages.

The Wallace Forgie Centenary was celebrated during the year 1982. The Golden Jubliee Celebrations of Camp Tonakela were organised during 1988 and the Diamond Jubilee of the Camp will be celebrated during the year 1998.
