Mr. V.Muralidharan, a Software Engineer, and Mr.K.Thangaraj, a Master of Arts, and a Bachelor of Education were inspired by the life and teachings of Gandhi, Vivekananda and Bharathiyar, even during school days. They were engaging themselves in social service activities through Vivekananda Association which they formed along with a few young friends. They brought out a manuscript magazine Ragamaligai through which they gave expression to the fire in them.

After completion of studies they started 'Sevalaya' in a rented premises in Sivanvoil Village with five children. With the help and support of philanthropic public it has grown to shelter 114 children in its own premises at Kasuva Village in 4.5 acres of land. Apart from housing the Hostel, School, Medical Centre Library buildings, it is proposed to use this land for farming, craft-centres, Goshala etc., It is expected that the income generated by these activities will make Sevalaya self-reliant in course of time.




MESSAGE



Sevalaya - a brief report

'Sevalaya' has grown to greater heights during this year.

At present we are sheltering 114 children in our home of which 41 are girls. We have now acquired another Three acres of land which we hope will help us to generate our own income, making us self-reliant in course of time. School Building construction is under progress, and now we are in position to accommodate all classes from Balwadi to 10th standard in comfortable class rooms.

Recognition for the Mahakavi Bharathiyar Elementary School has continued, and recognition for the High school is on the way.

We also run a Balwadi supported by Indian Red Cross Society.

Our Library, reading room, and medical centre are well utilized by the village population. Vin Goshala has addition of a few more cows, providing good milk for our children. Besides, we maintain a few cows saving them from ending up in the slaughter house.

Our Audited Accounts are presented elsewhere in this report. We thank M/s. purushottam for rendering their services free of charges. Other areas of activities during the year 1998 are given below.

Literary, Cultural and Social Activities

Sri Rama Navami was celebrated on 4th April. Mr. Rangaramanujam spoke of the value children have to imbibe from the life of Rama.

Bharathi Paasarai, Chennai and Sai Foundation Chennai joined with us for the program 'Pallithorum Bharathi' (Bharathi at every school) on April 5th in our Mahakavi Bharathiyar school.

"Gramamthorum Bharathi" (Bharathi at every Village) was observed with a "Villupai Bharathi" by Mr. Subbu Arumugham.

10th Annual day with Mr. D. I. Srivastava, General Manager, Engine Factory, Avadi as Chief Guest was conducted on August 9th. Mr. Babu, State First Rank holder in the 10th Standard Exam was honoured.



Independence Day was celebrated with participation as usual by Y's Men Club, Anna Nagar, and Y's menettes. Drinking water project for Sevalaya was inaugurated. Donor was Mr Chellaswamy. Mr.Indu Kaladharan President of the club and others spoke.

Educational Camps & Tours

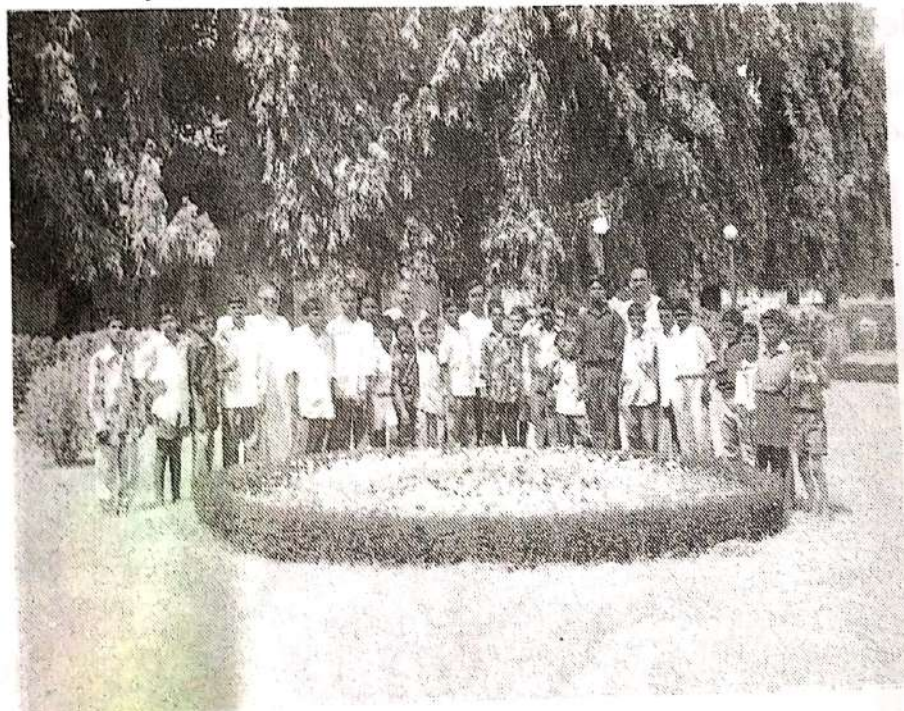

Human Resources Development

Induction Training for new members of the Teaching staff was conducted on June 6th, 2014th by Prof. T.R. Udaya Shankar, Dr. S.S. Rajagopalan, Mr. A. Annamalai and Mr. K. Mohan.

Our Hon. Co-ordinator Mr. T.S. Venkata Ramani was deputed to a Training programme in November on "Indian Ethos in Management" by Swami Someswaranda. The Programme was sponsored by "Samanvaya" a consultancy organization who allowed us free admission.

Mr. Krishnaswamy, Correspondent of Schools run by Mr. N. Mahalingam at Pollachi addressed our staff on the importance of craft centred education.

Five members of our Team have successfully completed the first year Examination: M.A. (Gandhian Thought), one M.A. (Religion & Philosophy) of Madurai Kamaraj University, and M.A. (Tamil) of Chennai University. They have taken up the II year of studies. New enrolment is also made every year. Free contact classes for 'Gandhian Thought' is arranged by Gandhi Study Centre, Chennai.

Our Staff regularly meet on Saturdays and each member reviews a book. There were several motivational talks by Mr. V. Muralidharan, Mr. K. Thangaraj and Mr. T.S. Venkataramani. The talk "An extra mile" by Mr. V. Muralidharan was well responded.

Special Training session on Gandhism and spinning was conducted for our children by Gandhi Peace Foundation, Chennai on 19th and 20th September.

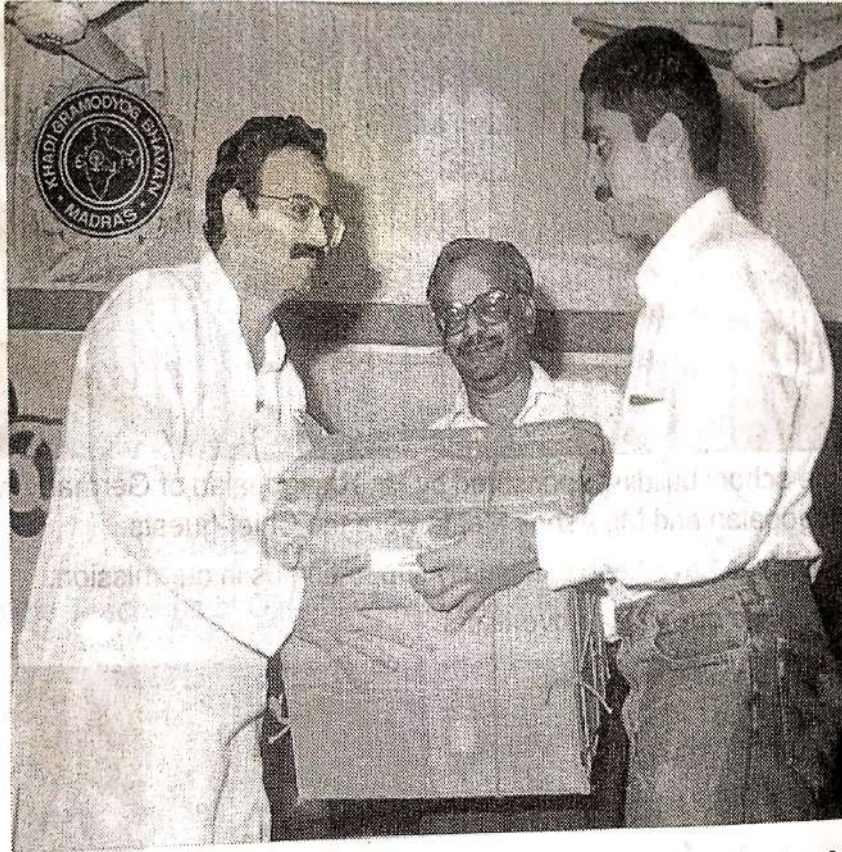
Mr. G. Krishnan, our inmate successfully participated in "Sathya Sodhanai" a Quiz on Gandhi conducted by Doordarshan during September.

4. To take care of the uplift of the rural areas surrounding Sevalaya in the matters of literacy, education, health care, civic awareness, gender equality, attitude building etc.,
5. Acquiring and developing adequate space with a salubrious climate and pleasant environment conducive to the physical, mental, and spiritual development of the children.
6. Inducting right type of workers, training and motivating them for a service oriented life time career for the organisation.
7. Through a continuous process of public relation activities, create a general awareness of the aims and activities of the organisation so as to gain moral support and the much needed resources.
8. Bringing in the concept of professional management to ensure maximum utilisation of human and material resources.

Activities

- (1) Swami Vivekananda Home for Boys and Mother Teresa Home for Girls: for orphan boys and girls
- (2) Mahakavi Bharathiyar free School: providing value - based, and life coping Education not only to inmates of the homes, but for the children of the surrounding villages, The thrust is on Craft-Education so that the children become self-reliant.
- (3) Mahatma Gandhiji Free Medical Centre: A Full-time Nurse, and visiting Doctors, are attached to the centre and periodic medical camps are conducted. The free service is extended to surrounding villages also.
- (4) Swami Vivekananda Free Library and reading room: Library contains about 3500 volumes of useful and rare books like Collected works of Mahatma Gandhi, Swami Vivekananda, Biographies of great Men, books on self-improvement etc. Magazines of great value like 'Wisdom' 'Ramakrishna Vijayam' etc. are subscribed to. The library caters to the needs of Kasuva and other surrounding Villages.
- (5) Vinobhaji Goshala: In this cow-protection centre, we rear cows which provide good milk for our children. Besides, we protect cows which have out-lived their period of "utility", thereby saving them from the slaughter-house.

More on our philosophy and activities

Our centre will be a nucleus around which a discrimination-free society will be formed. Our children are brought up in an atmosphere free from prejudices based on Caste, Creed, Religion, Language, Gender etc. The entrance to the campus specifically implores visitors to shed their prejudices, if any. Our application forms do not call for any information regarding caste or religion.

We constantly strive to find out the talents of the children and cultivate them. Our education includes craft-education, and our aim is that the children should become self-reliant.

We take care of the children till they are on their own. We support their higher studies till they find suitable employment.

Our services extend to the community. There is no facility for good education and medical services for about 6 kms from our campus. Even for emergency, people have to walk about 6 kms. In this context our services are found invaluable to the community.

We encourage the development of our staff members. Their higher-studies for M.A. (Gandhi Thought) of Madurai-Kamaraj University are sponsored by us.

Annual camp on Mahatma Gandhi, Swami Vivekananda and Mahakavi Bharathiyar, N.S. Camps by volunteers of city colleges, Intensive Training Programme for our staff, Exchange Programs with city schools, Tirukkural, Yoga, Karate Classes, Liaison with Service Clubs and voluntary organizations, celebration of important festivals of all religions, National Days & Religious Harmony Day etc., are some of our goal - oriented activities.

Mahakavi Bharathiyar School Building project

Sevalaya has a specific mission. Well being of the Nation depends on the proper development of the children, which is possible only by Character - Building, Value based Education. Normally the parents are to provide this, but for the orphan children, the duty falls on the society. It is this role of the society, that Sevalaya has undertaken to play in its own way. It is most likely that these less fortunate children, without anybody to support and guide them fall a prey to anti-social elements, and in turn they themselves turn anti-social. We have amidst us, many children, boys and girls who have been saved from going astray. We bring up our children in an atmosphere free of prejudices based on Caste, Creed, Religion, Gender, Nationality etc.,

Apart from orphan children, the school serves the needs of nearby villages. There are no schools nearby and there are many children around, of school going age, who are not attending any school.

It is our aim to develop our school with all infra structural facilities, and with best of expertise, so that these children from a very backward section of society receive the best of Education comparable to that received by their counterparts in the cities and achieve a good status in society. We want to prepare them for good positions through self employment, professional callings like Chartered Accountants, high profile careers/studies like IIT/Medicine/IAS/IPS etc.,

Outline of the project

The project is to construct a four storied building. The class rooms will be well ventilated and lighted. The complex will be equipped with a library, laboratory, Computer-lab, Auditorium, Prayer-hall, play ground etc., The construction will be in our own land in Kasuva Village.

Estimated cost of the project is Rs.112.28 Lakhs

Estimated duration of the project: February 1997 to December 2003

With Government of India providing cent-per-cent relief from I.T.for donors to this project we hope to muster this sum.

Estimated population that would be benefited by the project.

From the nearly 3000 families from the six nearby villages, atleast 1000 children who are now out of the purview of Education can be brought to the class room in the next five years.

Expected effects of the project

1. With the infra-structure of Building and facilities, we will be able to attract competent teachers to the village.
2. With the quality of Education, the life-coping skills, craft Education, Education in Human Life values etc., imparted, we are sure to attract more parents to send their children to the school.
3. Coming out of the school, the children are bound to be responsible citizens of the country, confident to face the world and stand on their own legs. We believe that we will form a nucleus of a society with self-confident men and women of good character free of any prejudices.
