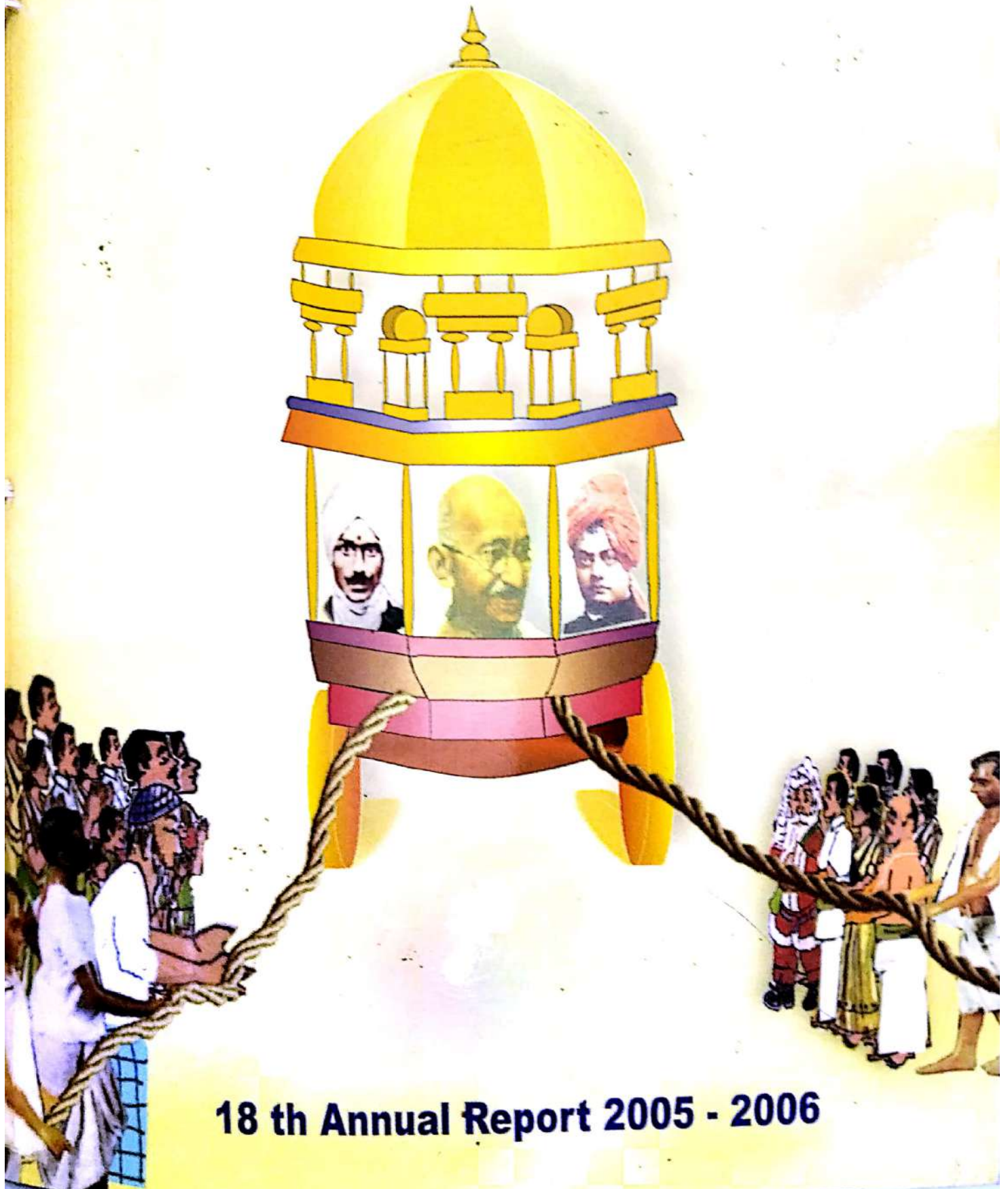

## A BRIEF HISTORY

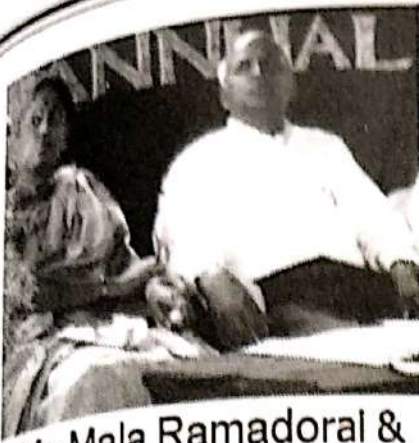
- Date of Establishment** : 29/05/1988

The institution was founded by V.Mralidharan and his friends inspired by the life and teachings of Gandhi, Bharathiyar and Vivekananda. They were engaging themselves in social service activities through Vivekananda Association which they formed along with a few young friends. They brought out a manuscript magazine Ragamaligai through which they gave expression to the fire in them.

After completion of studies they started Sevalaya in a rented premises in Sivanvoil village with 5 children. With the help and support of philanthropic public it is now engaged in wide ranging service activities in a sprawling seven acre complex. Apart from housing the Hostel, School, Health Centre and Library buildings, the land is used for farming, craft center, goshala etc. A free old age home for destitute senior citizens in the name of Sri Ramakrishna Paramahansa is also functioning under its care.



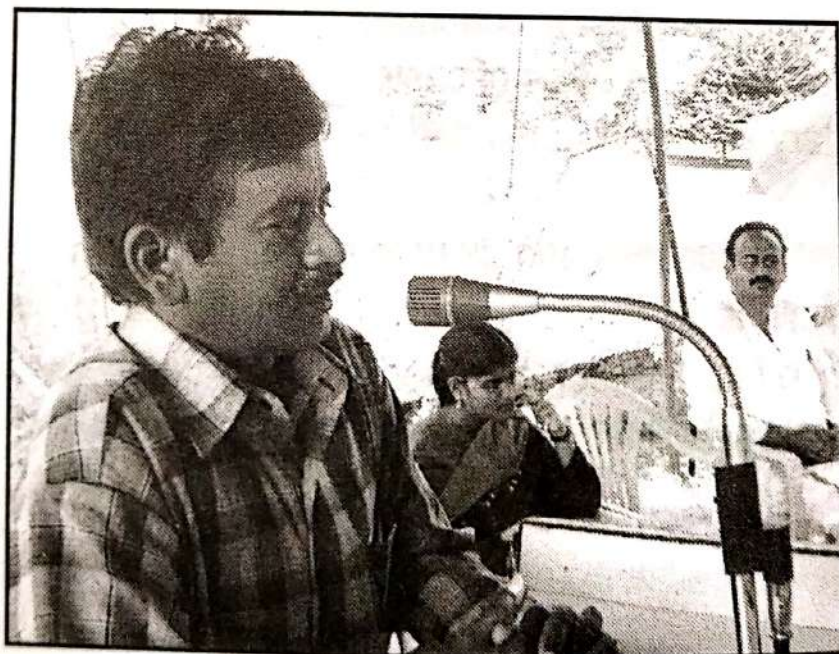

- Courage to do whatever one wants to do and the clarity to know what one wants.
- Courage to face and handle any situation in life.
- To bring to play one's potential to the fullest extent.
- Involvement and dedication to any task undertaken.
- A sense of discipline.
- Attuning with the Universal Energy through Prayer.



### Three Leading Lights

**Mahatma Gandhi, Swami Vivekananda & Mahakavi Bharathi.**

The Common thread in the philosophy of all these 3 great men is 'Serve the needy'.

One of Mahakavi Bharathi's poems which talks about Saraswathi pooja says the following:

Just uttering some mantras, keeping books in front of Saraswathi's picture and offering sandal and flowers is not real Saraswathi pooja. If you open schools in areas where there are no schools and ensure that there is not a single town in this country school-less, that is real Saraswathi pooja. Educating one poor person is a better deed than constructing 1000 'annadhana Salas' and 10,000 temples.

This poem is the foundation for our 'Mahakavi Bharathiar school'. Today orphan poor & destitute children get free and Quality education from this school.

Swami Vivekananda says that if someone is hungry, then food is the only God for that person. Even if a dog goes without food in this world, then there is no point in having any religion. Such powerful thoughts are the basis for the 'Swami Vivekananda Hostel' in Sevalaya. As 'Vivek' means 'wisdom', we have also named our library 'Swami Vivekananda Library'.

Mahatma Gandhi said that India lives in its villages. If we can improve the standard of living in the villages, then we would have done some real service. Hence all the activities of Sevalaya are carried out in a small village called 'Kasuva'. Gandhi has also spoken a lot about Indian medicine and nature cure. Hence our medical centre is called 'Mahatma Gandhiji Health Centre'.

### Name of the organisation

'Sevalaya' means 'Temple of Service'. Swami Vivekananda calls the poor man as 'Dharidranarayana'. Service done to poor and destitute is actually the prayers offered to the God. Bharathi also says that he who can't bear the sufferings of others, is a 'punniya murthy' (blessed soul). As service activities are going on for such Dharidranarayanas, the place is named as 'Sevalaya'.



## Symbol of the organisation

The Symbol shows that someone is watering a plant. Who is watering is a non-issue. Any seed sown in the land, needs conducive environment to grow. On the other hand, the tree is already hidden inside the seed. The environment is not creating the tree. The environment is only helping the tree, which is already inside the seed, to come out and grow. Swami Vivekananda has said that education should bring out the divinity, which is already in man. Such an education is man making and character building education. However, he also says that we can't even teach an ant. Hence at Sevalaya, we believe that we are only providing conducive atmosphere for the children to grow, so that whatever is hidden inside the seed, will come out and grow.

## Slogan

'Love all Serve all' is our slogan. We have to serve whoever is in need of our service, irrespective of which caste, religion or country he or she belongs to. Also the service should be done with love, remembering that we should thank that person for giving us an opportunity to serve.

## On the envelope

All Sevalaya envelopes carry the following Quote from Swami Vivekananda. 'The first of everything goes to the poor; we have right only to what remains'. We keep hearing sayings like 'Charity begins at home' and 'whatever is left over after we satisfy our needs, can be used for Charity' (தனக்கு மிஞ்சினதுதான் தான தர்மம்). But Swami Vivekananda says that first do charity and whatever is left over can be used for self. If Charity begins at home, most likely, it will end at home also. If we can provide for charity only after satisfying our needs, it is like taking bath in the sea after the waves stop, because our needs will always expand to match our increased income.

## Behind the visiting card

On the back of all Sevalaya visiting cards, we have printed the following Quote from Bharathi:

வயிற்றுக்குச் சோறிட வேண்டும் - இங்கு  
வாழும் மனிதருக்கெல்லாம் ,  
பயிற்றிப் பல கல்வி தந்து - இந்தப்  
பாரை உயர்த்திட வேண்டும்.

It means that we will provide food for all human beings; we will provide quality education in all fields and raise the standard of living in this world. We are trying our bit at Sevalaya to implement such a lofty dream of Mahakavi Bharathi.



## Thirukural

Our Children chant the following Thirukural before any meal:

பகுத்திண்டு பல்லுயிர் ஒம்பதல் - நானோர்  
தொகுத்தவற்றுள் என்னம் தலை.

It means that sharing and eating what you have is the highest form of Virtue. Donors who come and celebrate their birthdays, wedding days and observe memory days of their family elders sponsor many of the meal to children at Sevalaya. Our children pray for them before the meal and thank them for sharing and eating what they have, an exhibition of highest form of virtue.

## Invocation song

On all Sevalaya functions, our children sing 'Achamillai, Achamillai' (No fear, No fear), a song composed by Bharathi. Normally invocation songs are sung in praise of some God or Goddess. We have also heard from many that we should have fear of God. In Sevalaya, we believe that children should have devotion to God and not fear. We tell our children that as long as they have not done anything wrong, they need not fear anyone, including God. Bhagavad Gita also says that fearlessness is one of the virtues one should possess. To emphasise this fact, we sing Achamillai, as our invocation song.

## Two basic principles

As you enter Sevalaya, you will notice 'the writing on the gate' - 'Please shed all your preferences / prejudices, if any, based on caste, creed, colour, religion, language, sex, nationality etc., before entering.' We believe that is one of our basic principles at Sevalaya. We welcome all, whoever needs our service, or whoever wants to serve, irrespective of whatever 'group' they may belong.

All our services are rendered free of cost. We will not collect any fee from anyone. Our school is free, we give uniforms, books, notebooks etc, free to all children studying in our school. Even pick-up and drop is arranged free for children coming from outside. Our medical centre and library are all free for all the villagers. The old age home is also free and the inmates need not pay anything. We do this because, we are serving that section of the society, which cannot afford to pay for anything.

## Treating children & senior citizens

We have given enough training to our staff to treat our children and senior citizens with love and affection. Any sort of physical punishment is banned in our school. Serving these children and the senior citizens is the very purpose of our organisation.



## WE HAVE A DREAM !.....

Higher education in India has become very expensive. Many in the middle class struggle to send their children to colleges. If that is the case, think of the fate of poor and orphan children. Many are bright and if given a chance, they will shine very well in higher education. If an entire university is functioning to provide free education to the orphan and poor, we are sure, no one will stay away from higher education for financial reasons.

Imagine a university- huge in size, high in Quality, functioning from a small village, where there was not even a school, few years ago. Before Sevalaya started its own school in 1991, the village children had to travel six Kms. to reach the nearest school. Many of them would prefer to skip school and work in the paddy fields, for want of proper public transport and of course the all-important money. Currently the same village has a school with 32 class rooms, an auditorium, four labs, and a library. 800 children are getting the benefit of free education here. If this transformation is possible in 15 years time, give another 15 years or so, a university is also possible.

Thinking BIG is the first step. Let us take the first step, imagine 'A University at Kasuva'. Like all services rendered by Sevalaya, dreaming is also free ! With full support from each one of you, this dream will become a reality, in course of time.

## MORE ABOUT US

### LOCATION

The organization functions in a hamlet, Kasuva near Thiruninravur 42 km west of Chennai. This village which is the centre of our operations has undergone marked transformation in many fields in recent years through Sevalaya's service activities.

### ACTIVITIES

**Swami Vivekananda boy's Home and Mother Theresa Girls Home** are orphanages whose inmates are poor, destitute children. We provide them food, shelter, education, skill development and talent promotion besides the much needed love and affection. The children are looked after by us and remain with us till they can stand on their own legs.



They leave us when they get suitable employment. Many of them are well settled as plumber, mechanic, artisan etc. while a few hold positions of software engineers and bank officers.

**Sri Ramakrishna Paramahansa Old Age Home** supports poor and destitute senior citizens, male and female, where they live happily interacting with the community of Sevalaya including the children.

**Mahakavi Bharathiyar Higher Secondary School** (recognized) provides free education up to XII standard. All students are supplied free uniforms, textbooks and notebooks. Besides free transport is arranged for small children. Training in crafts and teachings of Gandhi, Bharathi and Vivekananda is a special feature of our school. The school has achieved cent percent pass in XII this year and X standard examinations of the State Board, for the past four years.

Our other service facilities include **Kasturiba Craft Training Centre** for village women, **Vinobhaji Goshala** for tending dry cows. **Mahatma Gandhi Medical Centre** and **Swami Vivekananda Library** (including a mobile library) all of which cater to the surrounding villages. All services are rendered free of charge and without any distinction of caste, creed, language or religion. There is no provision for religion or caste in our records. Our residents are treated with dignity in an atmosphere free from fear. Corporal punishment or any other form of humiliation is forbidden in our campus.

Towards our goal of attaining self sufficiency, our craft centre produces phenyle, envelope, home needs, garments, organic manure etc. We also undertake screen-printing and binding work. These items are made to high quality standards.

## YOUR PARTICIPATION

We solicit your participation in making our experiment in rural transformation a success. You can visit our service centre and spend a few hours with our residents, staff and volunteers. If you are happy with us, you can refer us to your friends and colleagues. You can also offer suggestions for improvement.



## Managing Trustees Report

Dear Friends,

With the support from each one of you, Sevalaya has completed yet another successful year. Year after year, our performance also increases – this year we were the only school in entire Thiruvallur district to get the distinction of achieving 100% results in both 12<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> standard board exams. Also this is the fourth consecutive year, we have achieved 100% result in 10<sup>th</sup> standard, which also is a record. To produce this kind of results, with poor, destitute and orphan children, in a village school is indeed a remarkable performance by all our staff and students. Donors also can feel proud and satisfied that their donations are well spent, for a worthy cause, with full effectiveness.

Thanks to the wide press and television coverage, we have become a known institution within Chennai and Thiruvallur districts. We have also developed good positive relationship with all Government agencies in the district and all of them are very helpful to our institution. As usual, our donor base has also grown. We are very happy that a large number of small donors are participating in this noble cause. It is worth mentioning that throughout the year we got all vegetables and fruits free from the Koyambedu market vegetable vendors. Many villagers came forward and donated rice, as they got very good crop this year, thanks to heavy rains in and around Chennai.

That two of our students have been selected for district level sports events, is another point to show that our children are not just 'all work and no play' kids. During the year, Sevalaya kids participated in many sports competitions and won many prizes. There were regular quiz programs, cultural programs etc., throughout the year.

One of our long term goals is to become 100% self-sufficient for running expenses by 2010. Based on this goal, we had taken up a goal for the year 2005-2006 that we should become 25% self-sufficient by 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2005. With support from all of you pouring in for our corpus fund and by way of small sales of items like phenyle, soap oil etc., we are very



happy to inform you that the goal for this year has been met. Yes, we are on our march towards self sufficiency. Our professional way of management in fixing measurable goals and monitoring them month after month, has yielded results.

We are also very happy that we established contacts with two American universities this year. Stanford University helped us with preparing a detailed blue print for Sevalaya's rural university and John Hopkins university students will be visiting us in August 2006 for a 10 day NSS camp. Sevalaya is the choice location for many city schools and colleges for NSS camps, but this year we will see an 'international NSS camp'!

Our 'Goshala' is growing from strength to strength, as the cows we bought have produced more calves and thus paving way for more milk production. All other units, old age home, craft centre, health centre, library etc., are all functioning very well. As a cost cutting measure, we closed our city office and moved all office function to campus itself.

Details of all our activities during the year can be found in this annual report.

As usual, we have drawn up plans for the next year and all staff and trustees have set their own goals for the year and started working on them. With your support, we will exceed the goals set.

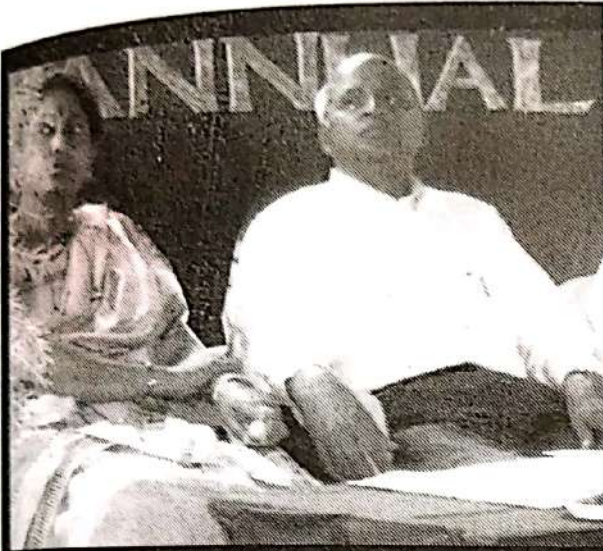

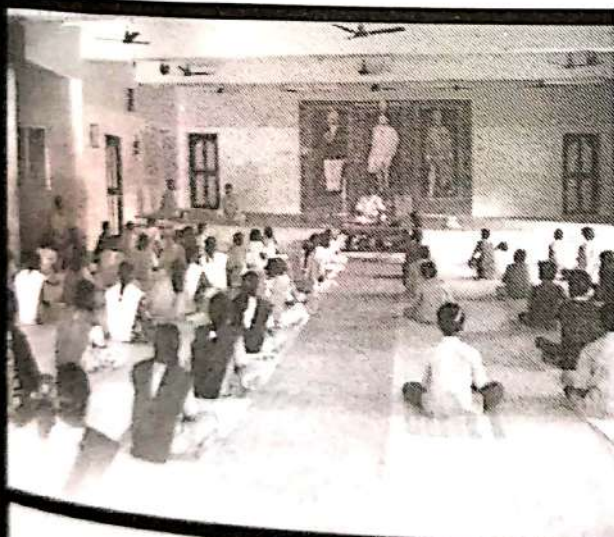


**Annual Day**

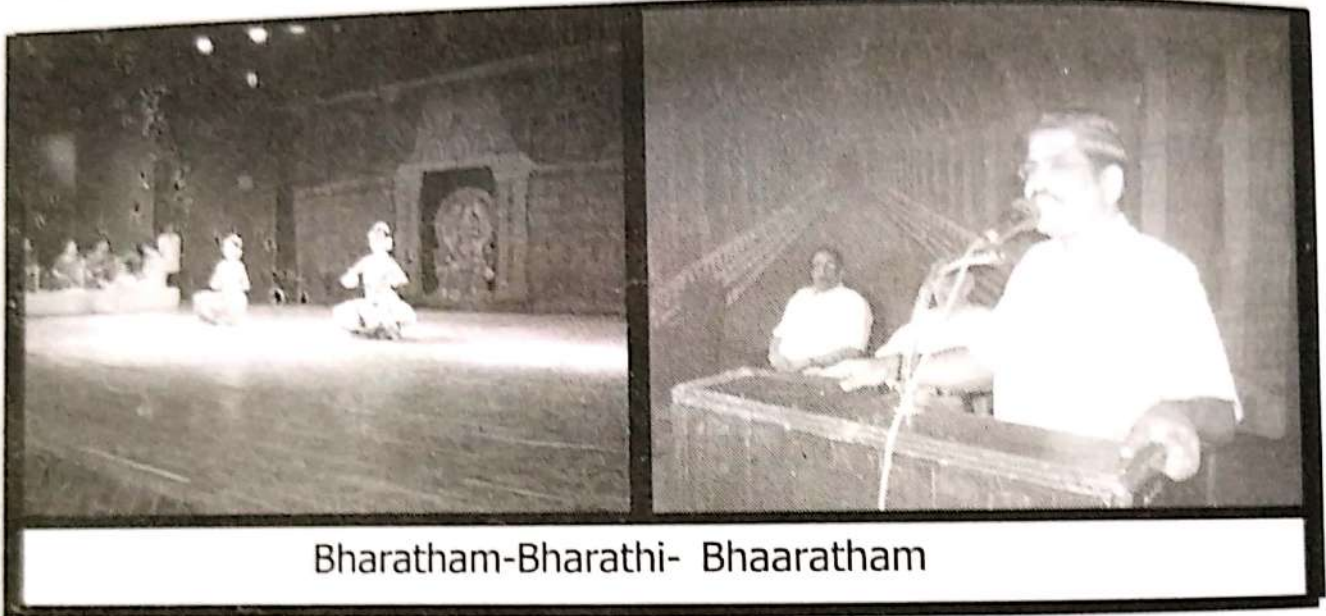

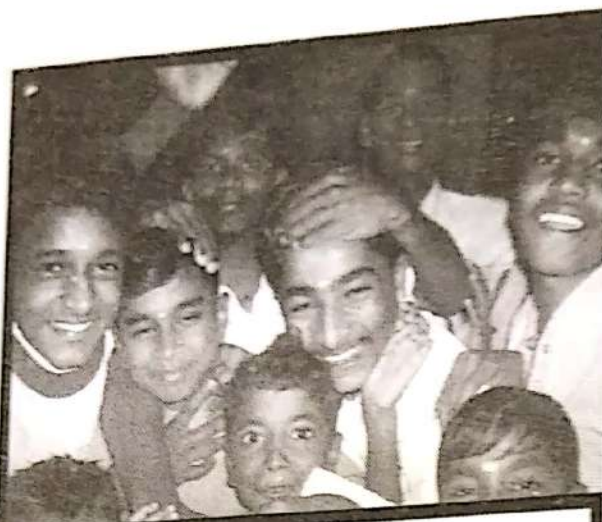

Pongal is the harvest festival of Tamilnadu. It marks the onset of harvest season and the occasion is celebrated as a thanksgiving function for the friends of the farmers- The Sun God and the cattle. It is celebrated for 3 days. The first day is Bhogi – when people clean up their houses, dispose off old and unwanted items. The second Day (The first day of Tamil month "Thai") is celebrated as Pongal. People worship Sun God. Bulls are specially reared for this purpose.

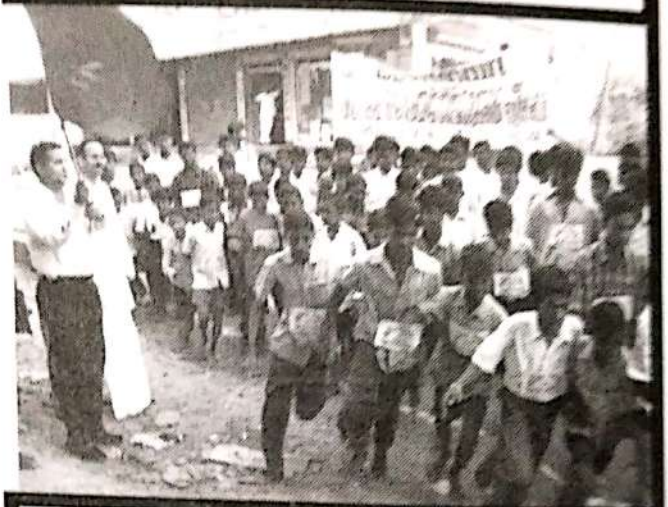

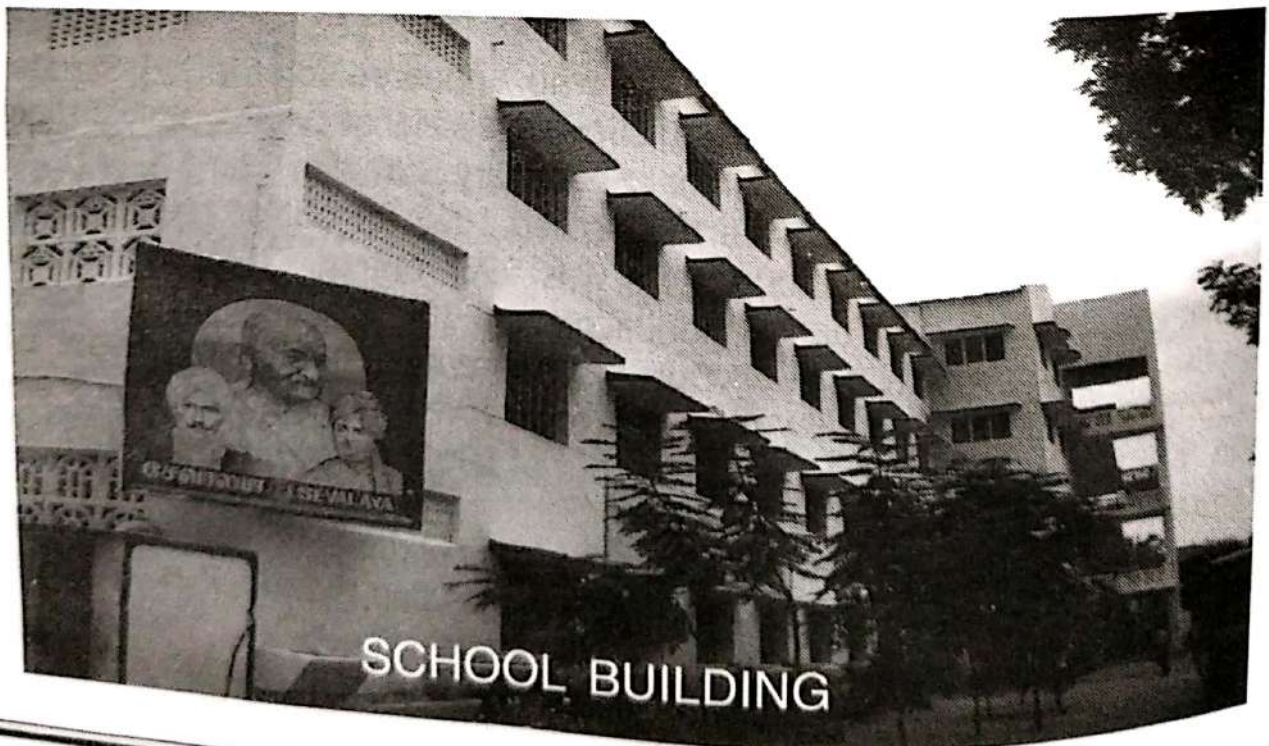

# A university created over cyberspace

## How Sevalaya linked up with Stanford for rural varsity project

CHENNAI: Waiting to be born in a suburb close to Chennai is a university that was constructed virtually over email. And perhaps, e-conference.

When the rural university finally comes up near Thiruninravur, perhaps the people behind the project will fete technology even as they thank a bunch of students working remotely at the University of Stanford, US, for their contribution. But that is nearly the end of the story.

This one began at a seminar on the tsunami conducted by IIT Madras in which representatives of Tata Consultancy Services and Stanford University participated—more particularly, V. Muralitharan of TCS and Ashwin Mahalingam, then a student at Stanford and member of the Business Association of Stanford Engineers, a group that was created 10 years ago and has since branched into social entrepreneurship.

Muralitharan, who is al-

so managing trustee with Sevalaya, a charitable organisation run on Gandhian principles, explained the concept of creating a rural university that would practise what it would preach: Sustainability, education and community. Mr. Mahalingam, who has since graduated, was attracted by Sevalaya's thrust on sustainability. He put forth the proposal to the Business Association of Stanford Engineers who then advertised for a three-credit, ten-weeks course at the varsity. A class of 15, people from various countries and specialising in various disciplines, finally settled in to take the course between September and December last year.

They started out with a mandate to build "a flexible, integrated university design ... through the exploration of sustainable energy, water, materials, and architecture."

How did they arrive at sustainable then? "The design would have to be economically viable, environmentally friendly and socially equitable," Mr.

Mahalingam says.

And that fitted perfectly with the ideals of Sevalaya. "We were on the same wavelength," Mr. Muralitharan explains, "And that had not happened with a number of Chennai-based architects."

So, the team at Stanford got to work, with cultural and geography specific issues in mind, examining design through three different perspectives: energy, water and materials. Every week they would work on developing the system and communication, either through email or video conferencing, would go back and forth, to clarify and sort out issues. The final blueprint is now ready to be built on about 20 acres. "When the funds start coming in," Mr. Muralitharan says.

## Value-based education

**GANDHIAN EXPERIMENT IN EDUCATION:** R. Thandapani; pub. by Thaayaram, Middle Street, Vellanoor & Post, Mayilam, Dindivanam Taluk-604304. Rs. 30.

At the outset, this book raises a substantial question of ethics: "Can work done for wages be called service?" Then the author proceeds with an assertion that Gandhian educational policy based on Sarvodaya and non-exploitation can be a panacea for the ills afflicting the young minds.

The author, R. Thandapani, uses the example of Sevalaya, a voluntary organisation that functions from the village, Kasuva, close to Tiruninravur near Chennai, which provides education to orphaned and destitute children, to substantiate his assertion.

The book, using this example, describes how a group of like-minded individuals came together to form a trust and

started a children's home, and its growth into a higher secondary school and the curriculum's specialities.

The curriculum followed is known as 'BGV (Bharathiar, syllabus'. Education here, the author says, is related to life, character building, promoting individual talent, inculcating ethical values and promoting positive attitude to life.

A chart depicts the concept of 'Education for all-round development' with its components of language and music; drawing and drama; moral and spiritual activities; social service; and games and sports.

The author quotes Sevalaya's head Muralidharan as saying that "the institution's goal is to establish a world class university in a rural area like Kasuva." Describing the institution as 'a Gandhian experiment in education', the author notes the scheme enunciated by the Mahatma is best suited to India as it centres round the individual and on social welfare.
